<u>AMENDMENT</u> NUMBER THREE TO THE 2013-2014 SMALL GAME - FURBEARER PROCLAMATION

2014 SPRING LIGHT GOOSE HUNTING SEASON

The following sections of the 2013-2014 Small Game-Furbearer Proclamation as amended and dated July 22, 2013 are amended for the 2014 Spring Light Goose Hunting Season to read as follows.

10. LICENSES OR SPECIAL PERMITS.

<u>Resident hunters</u> must possess a hunting certificate, a small game license, a general game and habitat license, or a combination license for either 2013 or 2014.

Non-resident hunters must possess a 2014 non-resident spring light goose license.

A Federal Duck Stamp is not required.

All migratory game bird hunters must be certified through the Harvest Information Program (HIP) for 2014.

- 38. GEESE. Light geese include snow geese (white and blue phase) and Ross's geese. Light geese may be taken statewide from February 15, 2014 May 18, 2014. There shall be no daily or possession limit on light geese.
- 39. SHOOTING HOURS. Shooting hours for 2014 Spring Light Goose Hunting Season shall be from one-half hour before sunrise to one-half hour after sunset each day.
- 42. ELECTRONIC CALLS AND WEAPONS. Electronic and recorded calls as well as shotguns capable of holding in excess of 3 shells may be used to take light geese during the 2014 Spring Light Goose Hunting Season.
